Why should you participate?

What does participation involve?

- Two friendly, face-to-face conversations with one of our researchers:
 - ▶ **Biographical interview** – you share your life story in your own words
 - ▶ **Reflexive interview** – we ask a few follow-up questions and invite you to correct or update any information you provided
- Everything you share will be treated with **respect** and kept **confidential**

- *With your permission, interviews will be recorded only for research purposes*
- *All names and identifying details will be anonymised unless you prefer to be identified.*
